Stay with us

Set within our visitor centre the park now hosts a 35-bed bunkhouse; split across nine rooms, two floors and includes accessible rooms suitable for all abilities. Residential trips can cater for up to 60 children with accommodation including a camping experience for those not staying in the bunkhouse.

The bunkhouse has been furnished to quality standards to ensure your stay is very comfortable.

Fun aside, our aim is to empower children with skills that will assist them in their day-today lives, to challenge their personal ability, make them think creatively as a team and individually and improve their communication skills. The multi-activity experience will not only provide positive memories but help improve their physical health and mental wellbeing by being outdoors and part of a beautiful, natural landscape.

We support school groups with programmes which are bespoke to your requirements. Each programme has its own course coordinator, and your outcomes are discussed and agreed before your visit.

Our activities run each year between May and September and cater for Year 4 and above. Please note that activities may change and are weather dependent. Visits include two activities in the morning and afternoon (however if SUP is undertaken this would be one activity only). For day activity bookings, a packed lunch is provided. For residential trips, breakfast and evening meals are provided in addition to lunch.



Guests will have access to a spacious dining and seating area which provides amazing panoramic views of the lake.

We take security seriously. Our gates are closed at night and access information will be provided on arrival to enable visitors to enter and leave at their convenience. We have overnight security at the park for additional peace of mind.
